<input type="checkbox"/>	Form A – used if your country is part of the Generalised Scheme of Preferences	Certificate of Origin
<input type="checkbox"/>	EUR.1 – used if your country has signed the preferential trade agreement with the EU	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proforma Invoice – used to show importer exact amount to be paid and payment method	Commercial Documents
<input type="checkbox"/>	Commercial Invoice – used by customs authorities as evidence of export	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Packing List – used to specify number of goods in individual packages and gives gross and net weight	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Phytosanitary Certificate – some natural ingredients for health products require testing before being exported	Administrative and Transport Documents
<input type="checkbox"/>	Health Certificate – suppliers must provide to EU customs authority if exporter country is part of a stricter import condition	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Transport Documents – depending on mode of transport, including Bill of Lading, Road Waybill, Rail Waybill, Airway Bill and FIATA Bill of Lading
